

Tapes are digitized and files are put on a USB thumb drive. I charge \$20 for a 128GB USB thumb drive. If your project requires more than 128GB I will contact you to see if you want to purchase another drive. Typically, 128GB will store 10 hours of video.

The maximum amount of footage I can put on a DVD with good quality is 2 hours. Most tapes are 2 hours or less. So, I transfer one tape to one DVD. Each of these transfers is \$10 and includes the straight transfer cost, the DVD, a custom printed label, and case.

Some VHS tapes can be recorded in Long Play format. This allows the tape to hold up to 6 hours of video. I can still transfer this tape to DVD, but can only put 2 hours on the DVD. So, in this case, the tape would be put onto 3 DVDs at a total cost of \$30.
